

 **WHAT IS IT? (RATIONALE)**

Math can be fun. And, all of those things we learned as children in math classes really are usable, like adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing. Even rounding and fractions are part of everyday life.

Remember to use only the functions that they are studying.

 **ADAPTATIONS**

Have the children roll two dice and add, subtract, multiply, and divide the two numbers.

 **GETTING STARTED (PROCEDURES & MATERIALS)**

Have the children work in pairs or groups. Deal out all of the cards. It doesn't matter if some students get more cards. Have the children add, subtract, multiply or divide the red cards in their hand. Do the same with the black cards. Have the students pass 3 cards to the person on their left. Repeat the activity. Make sure the students in the group agree with the answers.
